A ACADEMIA PARAENSE DE MÚSICA, pessoa jurídica de direito privado, com sede na Rua da Paz, s/n, Bairro Centro, CEP 66.017-210, Belém-PA, inscrita no CNPJ nº 04.226.577/0001-77, neste ato representada, por sua presidente Sra. ELIANA CAMARA CUTRIM, inscrita no CPF nº 042.494.452-91, torna pública a abertura de inscrições e estabelece normas para a realização de **PROCESSO SELETIVO PARA A AMAZÔNIA JAZZ BAND – AJB – 2021** visando o preenchimento de 22 (vinte e duas) vagas, bem como a formação do cadastro de reserva para a Amazônia Jazz Band, conforme adiante.

1. PERÍODO DE INSCRIÇÕES E DOCUMENTOS NECESSÁRIOS

1.1. O interessado em participar do processo seletivo deverá se inscrever entre os dias 05 de maio de 2021 a 20 de maio de 2021, de forma online no seguinte endereço: www.apm.mus.br;

1.2. No ato da inscrição, o candidato deverá enviar dois vídeos através de links: um referente à sua performance musical, na qual tocará as peças solicitadas para o seu instrumento e, outro link, em que constará um vídeo com a sua performance em improvisação. Esta improvisação se dará sobre os 12 compassos do gênero Blues na tonalidade de Bb maior.

1.3. O candidato ao instrumento de percussão também deverá enviar dois vídeos através de links: um referente à sua performance musical, na qual tocará as peças solicitadas para o seu instrumento e, outro link, em que **deverá ser demonstrado proficiência nos seguintes ritmos: salsa, samba, bolero, montuno e rumba.**

1.4. O candidato à vaga de contrabaixo deverá demonstrar, no seu vídeo de performance musical, proficiência no contrabaixo acústico em ao menos duas músicas das quais a partitura estará disponível na ficha de inscrição.

1.5. O interessado deverá preencher o formulário de inscrição no site da APM, www.apm.mus.br, anexar release artístico, currículo vitae, documento de identidade e, enviar os links das performances, com o programa referente ao instrumento pleiteado.

1.6. Haverá cadastro de reserva das vagas previstas neste processo seletivo para o caso de desistência, reprovação ou desligamento de qualquer dos inscritos já habilitados, com validade de 1 (um) ano;

1.7. A Academia Paraense de Música – APM - divulgará os resultados do processo de seleção através do site: <http://www.apm.mus.br>



1.8 As partituras das peças de que trata o item 1.2 estarão disponíveis na ficha de inscrição on-line, e em anexo neste regulamento. O playback referente aos 12 compassos do Blues em Bb, estará disponível somente na ficha de inscrição on-line.

1.9. Os vídeos da audição deverão ser publicados primeiramente em uma conta **privada** do YouTube na forma **não listada** e, posteriormente, os links gerados deverão ser enviados no formulário ONLINE de inscrição.

1.9.1. A Comissão Avaliadora não se responsabiliza por qualquer falha no envio da documentação, falha no sistema ou na execução dos vídeos, bem como pela qualidade do equipamento usado para a gravação. É do interesse do candidato que o equipamento seja da mais alta qualidade possível, contudo, a manipulação da qualidade de som e afinação através de programas de software resultarão na desclassificação do candidato. **O vídeo deve ser filmado em câmera única, parada e sem edições no meio das peças.** Entre cada uma das peças, entretanto, é permitido que a gravação seja pausada.

3. DAS ATRIBUIÇÕES DOS MÚSICOS E VÍNCULO JURÍDICO COM A ACADEMIA PARAENSE DE MÚSICA

3.1. Os aprovados integrarão a Amazônia Jazz Band, atualmente administrada pela Academia Paraense de Música, nos termos do Regimento Interno da AJB

3.2. Os aprovados terão carga de trabalho de até 6 (seis) horas diárias, 30 horas semanais, computando-se, nesse período, o tempo destinado ao estudo das peças em seu domicílio, aos ensaios e concertos;

3.3. Os ensaios obedecerão a carga horária mínima de 3h diárias, sendo assim de 14 hs às 17 hs, de segunda à sexta-feira e, pelo menos, 33 (trinta e três) concertos anuais a serem definidos pela Academia Paraense de Música;

3.4. A agenda de apresentações e a carga horária podem variar de acordo com a demanda da entidade concedente do termo de fomento, no caso a Secretaria de Cultura do Estado do Pará.

3.5. A natureza jurídica do vínculo entre o interessado aprovado e a Academia Paraense de Música é celetista, não gerando vínculo ou responsabilidade de qualquer natureza perante a Administração Pública Estadual.

4. DAS VEDAÇÕES

4.1. De acordo com o art. 24, inciso II c/c inciso III, alínea “b” ambos do Decreto Estadual 1835/17, é vedada a contratação de servidor ou empregado público, inclusive aquele com contrato temporário ou que exerce cargo em comissão ou função de confiança, vinculados à Administração Pública direta ou indireta do Estado do Pará, ou seu cônjuge, companheiro ou parente em linha reta, colateral ou por afinidade, até o segundo grau.

4.2. No caso de participação e aprovação de servidor público ou empregado público, nos termos do item anterior, deverá o interessado, antes da contratação, comprovar documentalmente a extinção do vínculo com a administração pública direta ou indireta do Estado do Pará.

4.3. O candidato poderá se inscrever nos dois corpos artísticos (OSTP/AJB) gerenciados pela Academia Paraense de Música, contudo, em caso de aprovação nos dois corpos artísticos, deverá optar por apenas um deles no momento da contratação.

4.4. Não serão permitidas inscrições de pessoas civilmente incapazes segundo a legislação civil.



5. DA COMISSÃO AVALIADORA

5.1. Será designada uma comissão de avaliação dos candidatos inscritos e habilitados, formada por 3 (três) jurados do cenário musical paraense, de reputação ilibada e notório conhecimento da matéria em exame;

5.2. A banca de seleção é soberana em sua decisão, não cabendo recurso pelo mérito da pontuação atribuída pelo jurado, mas somente em caso descumprimento das normas do edital.

6. DA AVALIAÇÃO

6.1. Cada membro da banca atribuirá nota de 05 (cinco) a 10 (dez) pontos, sendo permitida a utilização de fração decimal de um dígito.

6.2. A avaliação será baseada nos seguintes critérios:

a) artísticos – 4 Pontos

b) técnicos – 3 Pontos

c) estilísticos – 2 Pontos

d) avaliação curricular – 1 Ponto

d-1) Anos de atuação em uma orquestra profissional – 0,5 (0,1 para cada ano, até 5 anos podem ser computados)

d-2) Doutorado em Performance (no instrumento para o qual pleiteia vaga) – 0,2

d-3) Mestrado em Performance (idem) – 0,2

d-4) Bacharelado em Performance (idem) – 0,1

6.3. A nota final dos candidatos será a média aritmética das notas atribuídas pelos membros da Comissão Avaliadora.

6.4. Serão aprovados os candidatos que obtiverem nota superior a 8,0 (oito) pontos, em ordem decrescente até o respectivo número de vagas disponíveis. Para fins de complementação do cadastro de reserva, serão classificados os candidatos que obtiverem nota superior a 7,0 (sete) pontos.

6.5. Os casos de empate serão resolvidos recorrendo-se à maior nota individual das seguintes categorias, na seguinte ordem: 1º - Artístico; 2º - Técnico; 3º - Estilístico; Avaliação curricular.
